When do we call?

- A reasonable cause to suspect abuse, neglect, or sexual assault of a child under the age of 18, and under the age of 21 with a developmental disability or physical impairment

Who is mandated?

- Cleric and anyone acting in an official or professional capacity of leadership role within the church.

Who to call?

- Police (where the offense took place) OR Children Services (where the child resides) OR number above

What info should we have ready?

- Name, address of child, child's parents, child's age, nature and extend of injuries, abuse, or neglect
